

Service Learning Publication Grant

Submission Deadline: The last day of each month starting in September 2021

Awards will be made throughout until all allocated funds have been committed for the fiscal year.

General Information

The goal of these grants is to help service-learning instructors extend the reputation of the UA Service Learning Initiative through publication of their service learning activities in professional journals or other relevant outlets. The Service Learning Initiative has allocated \$10,000 for publications in the 2022 Fiscal Year.

Publication Grants

Available funds can be awarded to projects to support publication in a variety of outlets. Any proposal can be awarded up to \$1,500.

Application Deadline

The last day of the month

Applicant Eligibility

The applicant must be the lead instructor of a course that is being taught as service learning in the last two academic years at time of application. Additional co-applicants can be faculty, staff, or graduate teaching assistants of any title and rank. All applicants must be UA employees. Applicants' eligibility will be confirmed through department head/chairs and/or college deans. Regardless of the number of named applicants, awards are limited to \$1,500 per course.

Use of Funds

Publication/page charges for a manuscript

For funded applications, purchases must be initiated in Workday by the lead faculty member's department.

All forms must be submitted electronically through InfoReady. Please see our website for the <u>link</u> to the grant information page. Requests will be reviewed within two weeks of application deadline. Grants will be awarded until funds are depleted.
